MILITARY RECRUITERS CAN OBTAIN PERSONAL INFORMATION ON YOUR SONS AND DAUGHTERS UNLESS YOU ACT NOW TO PREVENT IT!

Unless you give written notice to your child's school, the "No Child Left Behind Act" of 2002 requires schools to give your child's name, address, telephone number, social security number, and other personal information to military recruiters.

To stop this, complete this form **FOR EACH HIGH SCHOOL CHILD** in your family. Make a copy for your records and mail the form to your child's school principal or—better yet—deliver it in person! Mail a copy to your School Board too. After all, didn't you elect them to serve your child's best interests!?

Effective immediately, you are hereby notified that NO PERSONAL INFORMATION, of any kind, on my child shall be given, mailed, electronically transmitted, or otherwise distributed to any military recruiter or any person requesting such information for the purpose of contacting my child with regard to military service. As parent or guardian, I reserve the exclusive right to determine whether or not my child shall receive literature or telephone or personal contact pertaining to military service.

Unless withdrawn or modified, in writing, by the undersigned, this privacy directive to withhold my child's personal information cannot be revoked or superceded, under any circumstance, and **shall remain in force throughout my child's tenure at this institution.**
